

# Prismacolor™ White Wizard

*Philodendron hybrid*

## FEATURES

This is a very sought after and rare variegated Philodendron. It has green leaves with very pronounced white variegation. This one is a climber, so be sure to give it a stake or moss pole for the best effect. Due to the nature of variegation, each plant is unique and will look slightly different, but all are beautiful!

## PLANT NEEDS

**Light Requirement:** Medium

**Medium** - Medium bright indirect light in the AM or PM, typically from an east or west window.

**Maintenance Category:** Moderate

**Preferred Temperature:** 60 - 85 °F

**Water Category:** Average

**Humidity Preference:** High

**Container Soil Type:** Indoor Potting Mix  
Needs Good Drainage

### Care Notes:

- Feed once per month at half strength when plant is actively growing.
- Bright filtered light, immitating what this plant receives in nature, is best. But early morning or late afternoon sun is beneficial when growing indoors. Sunny windows are particularly beneficial in the wintertime if you live in an area with shorter, dark days in the winter time.
- Do not place this plant in low light far from a window, otherwise you may lose variegation.
- Like any aroid, this plant prefers chunky potting mixes that provide plenty of air circulation to the root system. Amending your all-purpose potting mix with perlite and orchid bark is one way to accomplish this.
- Water when the top 1-2 inches of potting mix feels dry. They don't want to be wet all the time, nor do they want to dry out completely.
- These plants prefer high humidity.
